UNDERSTANDING THE WORLD

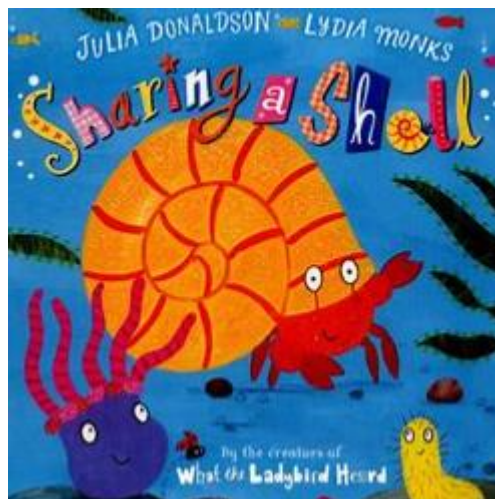
- Naming sea creatures and investigating their habitats
- Investigating the impact of rubbish in the oceans – how could this be dangerous for sea life?
- Look on a map and find the location of your nearest beach. How would you get there? How long would the journey take?

LITERACY

- Listening for and discussing rhyming words
- Freeze frame characters feelings
- Talk about the characters
- Continuing a rhyming string
- Drawing and labelling sea creatures
- Writing CVC words
