Topic

In Autumn 1 our topic is What a Wonderful World. We are going to learn the location of countries, continents and oceans of the world and build on our map skills using atlases, world maps and globes. In Autumn 2 we will be learning about the Gunpowder Plot using a variety of methods to fully develop our knowledge and understanding of this significant event in British history.

No Outsiders

During this term we are going to be looking reading The Great Big Book of Families by Mary Hoffman and Ros Asquith to learn about diversity. We will also read The First Slodge by Jeanne Willis to understand how we share the world.

These are for you to read and enjoy together and we ask parents to support their children with their reading on a nightly basis. Children who are still accessing Phonics will have their books changed weekly on a Wednesday. All other children will hand their books in on a Monday and Thursday to be changed if needed.

Homework

Year 2 will be set spellings today and year 1 will get spellings in Autumn 2. Spelling tests will be on a **Friday**. Those who have purchased the maths homework books will get those sent home as soon as they arrive in school. Maths homework will be collected in on a **Monday**.

We are going to be studying lots of exciting texts over the coming weeks. The first text we are looking at is Troll Swap by Leigh Hodgkinson and The Owl who was afraid of the dark by Jill Tomlinson.
